

These files set up Alfresco to have 3 additional content stores

- ImageStore
- VideoStore
- ArchiveStore

Note:

My install was on Windows and installed to c:\Alfresco

I suggest that you back up any files before overwriting with these sample files

Steps...

1) Copy content-store-selector-context.xml to -

C:\Alfresco\tomcat\shared\classes\alfresco\extension

This file define 3 additional content stores

contentstore.Images	=	ImageStore
contentstore.Archive	=	ArchiveStore
contentstore.Video	=	VideoStore

2) Copy aspects.get.properties.xml to -

C:\Alfresco\tomcat\shared\classes\alfresco\web-extension\site-webscripts\org\alfresco\modules\documentlibrary

This sets the display text for the attribute

3) Copy share-config-custom.xml to -

C:\Alfresco\tomcat\shared\classes\alfresco\web-extension

This file adds the cm:storeSelector aspect into the list of available aspects

4) Copy web-client-config-custom.xml to -

C:\Alfresco\tomcat\shared\classes\alfresco\extension

This will add the property/aspect to the webclient

5) Reboot the server. You should now be able to add the Store Selector aspect to any piece of content and then set it store location metadata to move the content.

- Optional -

To automate:

1) Load the two JS files into the scripts folder within the Alfresco repository. I normally create a sub folder to hold my scripts i.e.

Company Home > Data Dictionary > Scripts > Content Store

2) Set a content rule on a space. In my example I added two rules (these need to be done with the JSF Explorer client). One rule looked for new JPEG files and ran the StoreImage.js script and one that looked for MPEG4 files and ran the StoreVideo.js script.
